- 1. Cut the pictures and scatter them faced down on the table.
- 2. Take it in turns to choose a picture, turn it over, name the picture and say the number of syllables (2, 3 or 4).
- 3. If the answer is correct, the player keeps the card, if not, the card is placed back on the table face down.

Hint: When it is your turn do not always give a correct answer so as to make sure that your child fully grasped the skill.

Syllable division is done according to the pronunciation ze'bra, flow'er, pen'cil, rock'et, ba'nan'a, po'ta'to, te'le'phone, butt'er'fly, cat'er'pill'ar, wat'er'mel'on, hel'i'cop'ter, tel'e'vis'ion
