

Listening Project - A 17.1.3

1. Cut the pictures and scatter them faced down on the table.
2. Take it in turns to choose a picture, turn it over, name the picture and say the number of syllables (2, 3 or 4).
3. If the answer is correct, the player keeps the card, if not, the card is placed back on the table face down.

Hint: When it is your turn do not always give a correct answer so as to make sure that your child fully grasped the skill.

Syllable division is done according to the pronunciation

*ze'bra, flow'er, pen'cil, rock'et, ba'nan'a, po'ta'to, te'le'phone, butt'er'fly, cat'er'pill'ar,
wat'er'mel'on, hel'i'cop'ter, tel'e'vis'ion*
