
Listening Project - A 17.7.3

- 1. Cut the pictures and scatter them in a grid shape faced down on a table.
- 2. Take it in turns to flip pair of cards over.
- 3. With each turn, the player turns one card over, then a second card and if the pictures on the two cards have the same number of syllables, it is a match.
- 4. The player keeps the cards and scores a point.



Syllable division is done according to the pronunciation

rabb'it, pen'guin, ca'stle, pop'corn, snow'man, rain'bow, ba'nan'a, um'brell'a, wheel'barr'ow, com'pu'ter, straw'be'rry, as'tro'naut
