1. Find a small cardboard box. Turn it on its side with the opening facing away from the child.

2. Place between four to six familiar noisy items in the box, such as, a set of keys; a crispy packet; a squeaky toy; a bell; etc...







3. Whilst placing them in the box, show them to the child and demonstrate the sound that each item makes.



- 4. Ask the child to listen attentively and use one of the items in the box to produce a sound.
- 5. Invite the child to guess what the item is.
