
Listening Project - A 21_16.1.4



- 1. Cut the pictures and place them in a bag/sack.
- 2. Ask the child to pick a picture from the bag and hands it over to you.
- 3. Invite the child to say the single sounds of the word, e.g. /r/ /a/ /t/ and then the whole word, that is, 'rat'.
- 4. If it is correct, the child keeps the picture.
- 5. After all cards are covered spread them out on the table and invite the child to name the pictures once again.
- 6. Ask the child if there are any similarities in the words. Lead the child to notice that all the words rhyme and end in /at/.
