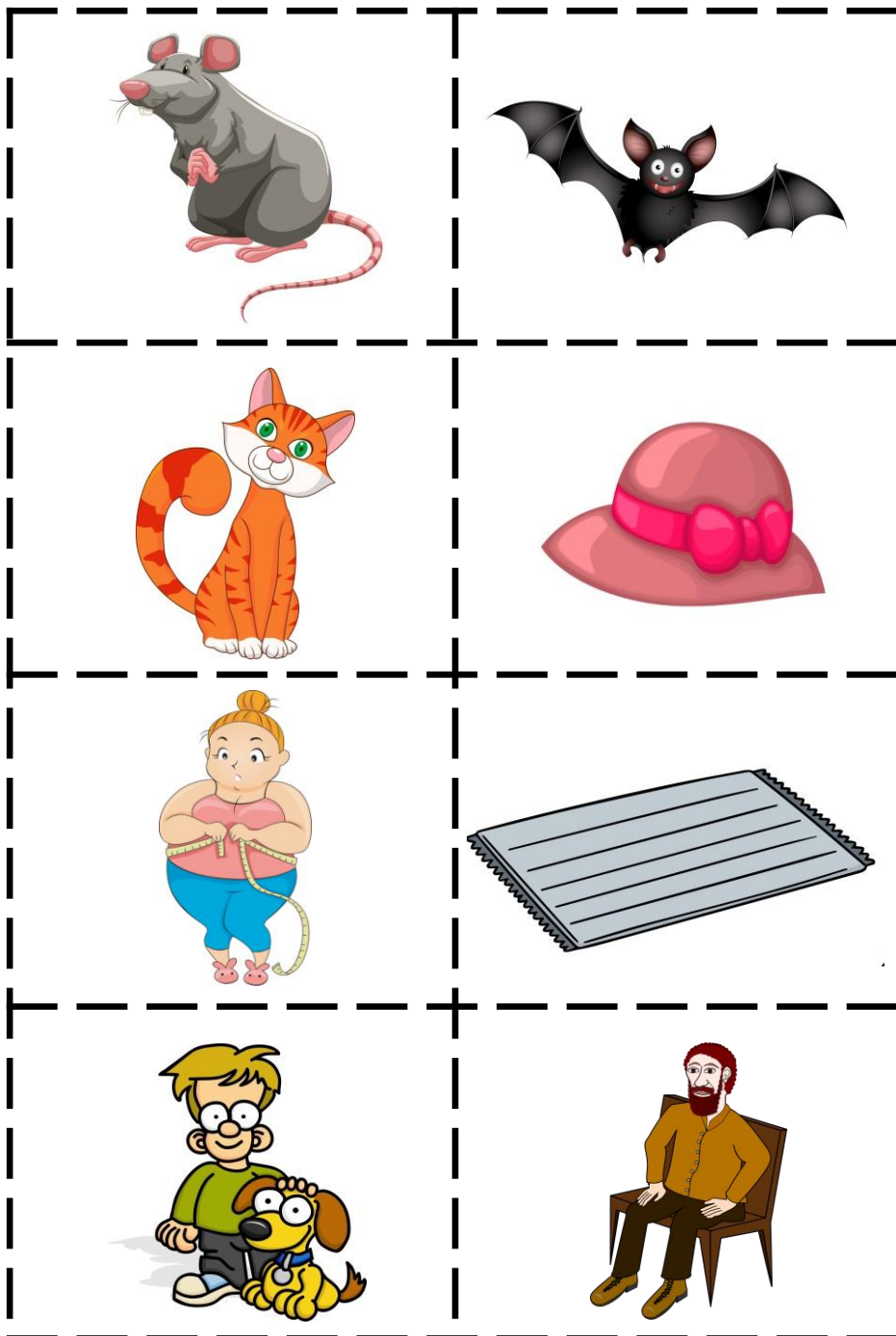


Listening Project - A 21_16.1.4



1. Cut the pictures and place them in a bag/sack.
2. Ask the child to pick a picture from the bag and hands it over to you.
3. Invite the child to say the single sounds of the word, e.g. /r/ /a/ /t/ and then the whole word, that is, 'rat'.
4. If it is correct, the child keeps the picture.
5. After all cards are covered spread them out on the table and invite the child to name the pictures once again.
6. Ask the child if there are any similarities in the words. Lead the child to notice that all the words rhyme and end in /at/.
