



1. Cut the pictures and place them faced down on a table.
2. Select a word from the list and say the individual sounds e.g. /c/ /a/ /n/.
3. Ask the child to put the sounds together and find the correct picture by turning one picture facing up.
4. If the picture is incorrect invite the child to place it faced down again and select another word from the list.
5. If the picture is correct, keep it faced up. Keep on playing until all the cards are facing upwards.
6. Once the game is finished, invite the child to name all the pictures and ask if there are any similarities in the words. Lead the child to notice that all the words rhyme and end in /an/.
